AWARD CONTRACT FOR 2ND AVENUE N.W. SIDEWALK PROJECT

AWARD CONTRACT TO LENDING INSTITUTION FOR RAW WATER PUMP STATION FINANCING BASED ON REQUESTS FOR PROPOSALS

Town Administrator David Epley informed the Board of the proposals submitted from lending institutions for the Raw Water Pump Station Financing.

Town Administrator David Epley and Finance Director James Cozart recommended going with Local Government Finance BB&T because it was the lowest bidder.
